Orientation

A comprehensive Orientation session for new students is held at the beginning of every semester. During Orientation, students will be provided with important information about accommodations, safety, immigration, Canadian culture and finances. In addition, students will review College-specific topics, such as accessing course resources, connecting with peers and instructors, finding work, accessing workshops and networking events, succeeding as an international student, and more.

Housing Options

Securing accommodation is the responsibility of students. The Toronto campus is easily accessible by public transit. Housing in North York and nearby communities can range from 1,000 - 2,500 CAD per month, plus personal expenses. Please budget and plan accordingly.

Co-op Work Term and Applied Project Fees

The fees listed above do not include the Co-op Work Term fee (\$900) or the Applied Project fee (\$2,800) that select programs require. These fees are not added to fourth semester tuition fees, rather, in place of the regular semester tuition fees for certain programs. Students are encouraged to participate actively in securing a Co-op Work Term and will be provided skill-building supports and access to employment opportunities from Loyalist College in Toronto. In the event that a student is ineligible or cannot secure a Co-op Work Term, they will complete an Applied Project in their final semester.
