<p>Student Health Plan</p> <p>Student Prescription Drug Plan: Provides a prescription drug plan for students that offers 80% coverage through a pay direct system to a maximum of \$3,000 per year (there are some exceptions). Birth control is included.</p> <p>Accident Benefits: Coverage for expenses related to an accident, i.e., life insurance, medical and dental expenses, emergency taxi, etc.</p> <p><i>Domestic students who can provide proof of pre-existing coverage may opt-out of the Prescription Drug Plan online during defined opt-out periods. Domestic students cannot opt-out of the Accident Benefits. Loyalist College does not provide reimbursements for this ancillary fee. It is up to the Student Health Plan provider to determine if the pre-existing coverage is satisfactory and issue a refund.</i></p> <p>Details can be found here.</p> <p><i>International students cannot opt-out of the Student Health Plan, including the Prescription Drug Plan and Accident Benefits, as your International Student Health Insurance does not provide adequate coverage. The cost of the International Student Health Plan is \$659.00. International Students are required to participate in the GuardMe Health Insurance.
