<p><b>Student Health Plan</b></p> <p><b>Student Prescription Drug Plan:</b> Provides a prescription drug plan for students that offers 80% coverage through a pay direct system to a maximum of \$3,000 per year (there are some exceptions). Birth control is included.</p> <p><b>Accident Benefits:</b> Coverage for expenses related to an accident, i.e., life insurance, medical and dental expenses, emergency taxi, etc.</p> <p><i>Domestic students who can provide proof of pre-existing coverage may opt-out of the Prescription Drug Plan online during defined opt-out periods. Domestic students cannot opt-out of the Accident Benefits. Loyalist College does not provide reimbursements for this ancillary fee. It is up to the Student Health Plan provider to determine if the pre-existing coverage is satisfactory and issue a refund.</i></p> <p><a href="#">Details can be found here.</a></p> <p><i>International students cannot opt-out of the Student Health Plan, including the Prescription Drug Plan and Accident Benefits, as your International Student Health Insurance does not provide adequate coverage.
