


Language Requirements

Loyalist College students are responsible for arranging their accommodations. In Belleville, we offer 476 spaces in five suite-style buildings, along with 104 spots in fully furnished townhouses, conveniently connected to campus. On-campus transit stops makes city amenities easily accessible while keeping classes within walking distance. Our newly renovated Port Hope Residence accommodates 20 students with shared facilities. The building is located a short walk from campus and downtown shops. Off-campus housing typically costs \$400 to \$800 CAD per month, not including personal expenses. Our Off-Campus Housing Officer can help you find safe and suitable place to live, so please plan and budget accordingly.




