- Food process operators are employed by food and beverage manufacturing and processing companies to operate, monitor, adjust and maintain food processing units and equipment.
- Industrial electricians lay out, inspect, assemble, install, repair and maintain a range of industrial electrical systems and equipment.
- Get job readiness and skilled trades experience to gain employment as an apprentice.
- Upon program completion, advance into an apprenticeship program or secure full-time employment in a manufacturing role.
- Your pre-apprenticeship training will automatically be recognized by MLTSD.

Admission Requirements

- Prospective students will need to be out of full-time work and school.
 - Exceptions will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, based on whether participating in fulltime education or occupational training will affect an individual's ability to participate in preapprenticeship activities and ability to enter into employment.
 - Interested applicants will be assessed through entrance tests in Math, English and Reading Comprehension (Ontario Grade 12 or Equivalent), followed by an interview to gain entrance to the program.

Additional Expectations for Training/Employment

- · Ability to commit to full-time training
- Reliable transportation
- Physical demands: Able to lift 50 lbs and fit to work in a labour role
- Interest in working in skilled trades or as an apprentice
