Any competitor that brings tools not mentioned above will be asked to remove them from the contest site.

SAFETY

Safety is a priority at the Loyalist College Skills Competition. At the discretion of the judges and technical chairs, any competitor can be removed from the competition site for not having the proper safety equipment and/or not acting in a safe manner.

1. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear approved closed-toed footwear. *

2. Jewelry such as rings, bracelets and necklaces, or any items deemed unsafe by competition judges, shall be removed. *

3. Proper shop attire is to be worn (no loose straps, baggy sleeves). Any attire that is deemed unsafe by competition judges will not be permitted. *

4. Cell phones are not permitted on the competition area

Step 1. Participant with the highest safety score.

Step 2. Participant(s) who has completed the project in the least about of time.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Immediate disqualification may occur at the discretion of the Technical Chair if a competitor displays any one of the following:

- Acts inappropriately
- Shows disregard for the safety of themselves or those around them
- > Breaks the established rules and regulations including:
 - Uses equipment or material that is not permitted
 - Dishonest conduct (cheating)
 - Speaks with those outside the contest area
 - Arrives to the contest site late
